Please inform us

In order to ensure that we have volunteer staff and facilities to meet your child's needs, you should inform us of any health, disability, social or behavioural needs which may affect your child while on camp. Please complete the basic health details requested when making your booking. It is particularly helpful to know details of any allergies or special dietary requirements. We may contact you for more information. A more detailed Health Form will be sent before the camp and must be completed and sent to the camp with your child. Young people with special needs are welcome at UR Camp Extreme. Please phone for advice and we will try to find a suitable way to help. If your child's first language is not English, please contact us and let us know.

Behaviour

We reserve the right to send home any child whose behaviour is compromising their own or others' safety, or adversely affecting the enjoyment and well-being of others. In these circumstances, we expect you to collect your child, however, if you are unable to you will be liable for any expenses incurred in returning your child home. In these circumstances, no refund will be available.
